Claim Your Reimbursement for Employee Training

CMTA approved for \$850,000 to reimburse YOU for trainings you are already doing.

What is ETP?



*The Employment Training Panel (ETP) awards millions of dollars every year to train California workers to be more efficient and learn new skills. **CMTA members get priority access and are eligible for exclusive savings through the program.***

How is ETP funded?

ETP is funded primarily through the California Employment Training Tax, which companies are required to pay. The program allows businesses to recoup a portion of those dollars to support employee training.

What are the requirements to receive reimbursement for training?

- Trainees must complete a minimum of 8 hours of training
- Trainees must be employed full-time
- Trainees must complete a post-training employment-retention period
- Trainees must be paid at least the ETP minimum wage during retention

Trainings Eligible for Funding

Class Topics - training hours can consist of one subject or a combination of topics, including:

- Business Skills such as Customer Service or Accounting
- Commercial Skills (Construction Skills)
- Computer Skills (Microsoft or Oracle programs)
- Continuous Improvement (Lean Manufacturing)
- Management Skills (Leadership Programs)
- Manufacturing and Warehouse Skills (Cross-Training in Production Operations)
- Literacy Skills (Vocational English or Math)
